TRAM RIDERSHIP RULES

Tram ridership is a courtesy provided by DESP

Students riding the Tram are expected to meet all West Valley College Student Code of Conduct rules, including but not limited to:

1. No name calling or badmouthing other students or WVC Personnel.
2. No noises or behaviors (for example, whistling or spitting) that could distract the tram driver
3. No foul language.
4. No smoking, eating or drinking on the tram (food and drinks can be transported if sealed or closed).
5. Students need to be at every pick up spot on time and not leave the area for 10 min. If tram is not there within 10 min., you can chose to go to your next class on your own.

Consequences for rules broken:

1. First infraction results in a warning and student needs to see counselor in DESP
2. Second infraction results in a loss of tram privileges for one week and student needs to meet with Chris and counselor
3. Third infraction student will be required to meet with the Vice-President of Student Services according to the College Student Code of Conduct/Disciplinary procedures.
