WHAT IS AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT)?

- The Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) is intended for students who plan to transfer and complete a bachelor's degree in a similar major at a CSU campus. Students completing this transfer degree:
- will earn an Associate's Degree from West Valley College;
 - are guaranteed admission to a campus in the CSU system;
 - will be prepared to start upper division coursework at the CSU
 - and will not need to complete more than 60 units after transfer.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Completion of 60 CSU-transferable semester units with an overall GPA of at least 2.0
- While a minimum of 2.0 GPA is required for CSU admission, some majors may require a higher GPA. Please consult with a counselor for more information.
- Completing courses prior to transfer that satisfy the U.S. History, Constitution and American Ideals requirement as part to the CSU GE-B or IGETC is highly recommended.
- LIB 04, PE Activity Class, Cultural Diversity Course, and READ 053 are NOT required for this degree.**
- Certified completion of either the California State University General Education Breadth pattern (CSU GE-B) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is required.
