Sign up for your Reading, English and Math assessment-you must have a student identification number to do this **SO** you must apply to the college **FIRST**. Please take the assessments seriously and study **BEFORE** taking them. You may only take some of the assessments **ONLY** once! There are preparation tests available on this sight -use them as a tool for success!

4. Sign up for a Counseling 000A class (Athletic Emphasis) Orientation.
5. **Students MUST attend both meetings for the orientation section that they chose or they will not pass the class. This class gives you registration priority for the next semester.**
 - A. Any other Counseling 000A may be taken for orientation credit **BUT** you will not have the athletic component on the NCAA/NAIA rules. You will also need to come into the athletic counseling office to make an electronic educational plan in order to play as well as make a folder for your sport.
6. **Bring in ALL transcripts** (sealed envelopes please) to the Counseling 000A meeting, including: **high school, other colleges attended whether graded or not completed** and **AP** test results. This will help your counselor assist you in helping to discuss and clear pre-requisites, as well as see if you have college level credit that may be used towards your educational goals.
7. **Go to the NCAA eligibility center to register if you think you are a qualifier.** We will discuss Qualifier versus Non-Qualifier status during the orientation. It will also help you to determine whether you will either need to have an Associates Degree to transfer or not. Knowing your qualifier status is important **IF** you wish to play sports at the next level.
